Concrete Show India 2019 – A Recap

The three-day event was held at Hall no 3, Bombay Convention and Exhibition Centre, Goregaon (E), Mumbai from 16-18 May 2019.

The event was exclusively focused towards the key Construction and Infrastructure assets covering key areas including roads & highways, housing, airports, ports, power, rail, dams & bridges.

The second day witnessed a focus on Precast Technology In Construction encompassing a wide range of applications in Industrial, residential and Infrastructure projects in India. There was also a unique focus on equipments for Pre-cast, Pre-fab technologies as well as a unique focus on Three-dimensional Modular Precast Solutions.

In addition to this, a variety of engagement platforms including the Innovation Zone, Student Incubation Cell, Start-up Zones and Business to Business & Business to Government enabled a strong interaction and participation from all stakeholders in the industry. Having delivered a successful 2019 edition the event is set on getting some exciting platforms into focus for the 2020 edition.

India's economy is big and getting bigger. The construction industry is the second largest industry in India after agriculture. Nearly all of the infrastructure sectors present excellent opportunities, with roads and highways, ports and airports, railways and power standing out as particular bright spots, with staggering sums of investment planned. Liberalization of government regulations and a deliberate strategy on the part of the Indian Government to promote infrastructure spells opportunity for engineering and construction companies.

There are various reasons to invest in India. For example, India is one of the world's fastest growing economies – and growth expected to continue at 7-7.5% despite the global downturn, few restrictions on foreign direct investment (FDI) for infrastructure projects, Tax holidays for developers of most types of infrastructure projects, some of which are of limited duration, opening up of the infrastructure sector through PPPs

With government's increased focus on programs like smart city mission, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, Industrial Corridors, Golden Quadrilateral Road Project the growth may exceed expectations.

As per recent article by research and markets, the construction industry in value terms is expected to record a CAGR of 15.7% to reach US\$ 738.5 billion by 2022.

Industry Projections:

- By 2025, Construction market in India is expected to emerge as the third largest globally
- By 2025, Construction output is expected to grow on average by 7.1% each year
- By 2022, Construction equipment industry's revenue is estimated to reach \$ 5 bn
- 100% FDI under automatic route is permitted in completed projects for operations and management of townships, malls/shopping complexes, and business constructions.
- 100% FDI is allowed under the automatic route for urban infrastructures such as urban transport, water supply and sewerage and sewage treatment.
